ORDINANCE NO. 670 A

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A RETAILERS' SALES TAX IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE PERCENT (1.0%) WITHIN THE CITY OF BURRTON, KANSAS, EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2027, AS A CONTINUATION OF THE EXISTING SALES TAX PREVIOUSLY APPROVED BY THE ELECTORS.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BURRTON, KANSAS:

SECTION ONE:

A majority of the electors voting thereon having approved, at an election held on the **4th day of November, 2025**, the continuation of the existing one percent (1.0%) retailers' sales tax in the City of Burrton, Kansas, for the purposes of generating revenue needed to provide for improvement and maintenance of the public streets and to pay bonds or other obligations of the City issued to finance such improvements as authorized by K.S.A. 12-187 et seq. and amendments thereto, **there is hereby levied a city retailers' sales tax in the amount of one percent (1.0%) to take effect on the 1st day of January, 2027, and to be levied through December 31, 2046.**

SECTION TWO:

Except as otherwise provided by law, such tax shall be identical in its application and exemptions therefrom to the Kansas Retailers' Sales Tax Act, and all laws and administrative rules and regulations of the Kansas Department of Revenue relating to the state retailers' sales tax shall apply to such city retailers' sales tax insofar as such laws and regulations may be made applicable. The services of the Department of Revenue shall be utilized to administer, enforce, and collect such tax.

SECTION THREE: Effective Date.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication one time on the designated official public site, and a copy duly certified shall be submitted to the State Director of Taxation.
